

May provide scholarships toward training, certification, or credentials in an in-demand career. Scholarships are awarded for up to two years at local community Colleges, and Career & Technical Centers.

High School Dropouts without GED could be eligible to get paid up to 20 hours per week while completing their GED & also get paid for 20 hours per week in work experience.
